

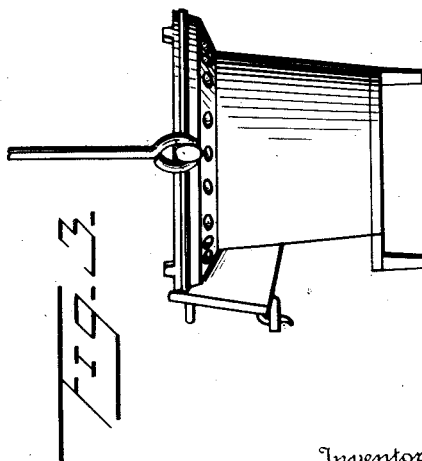
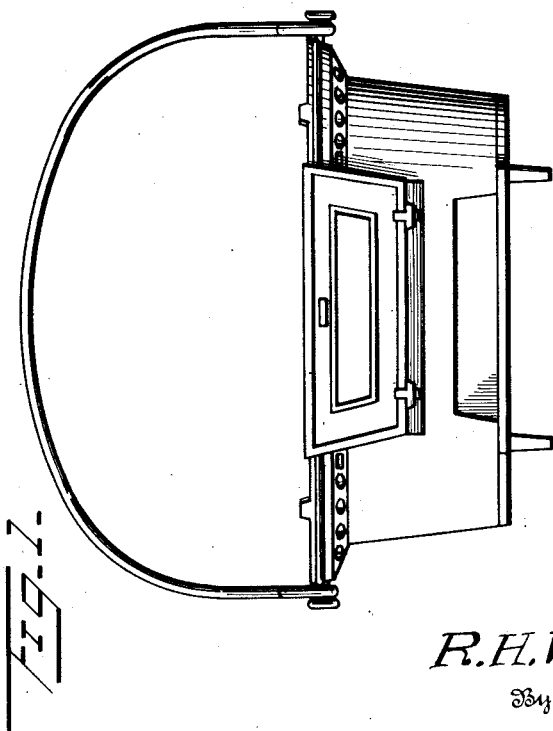
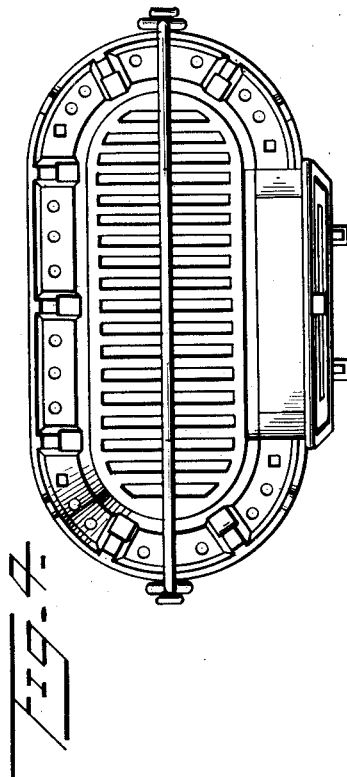
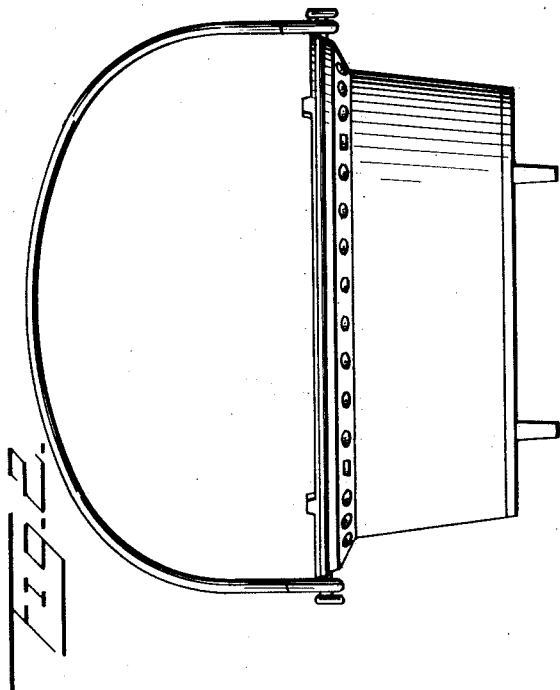

DESIGN FOR A PORTABLE STOVE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Bolling Jones, Jr., Robert H.
